On Thursday 6th, we had a meeting among **PReS Council members and WPs Chairs and Secretaries** for brief reporting on the discussion and proposals raised within each WP on Wednesday 5th:

- Almost all the priorities identified during the Imaging WP were raised also by other WPs
- Query (if felt useful/needed) on possible different name for WPs (taskforce? xx??)
- Then, Sylvia (Chair of the SLE WP) and Tamas (Chair of the Scleroderma WP) have detailed some proposals on website facilities, to be implemented for all WPs.

Sylvia and Tamas' proposals

1. Better visibility of the WP on PReS website at first sight:

Now drop down menu in upper line, but preferably a separate button on the first page that can be clicked and then link to a general introductory page for all WPs, with here links to the pages of the different WPs.

2. When applying for PReS membership, new and at renewal: when asked for PReS membership, applicants should be informed to join WP in the application form with a link present to the introductory WP page on the website.
 3. Central email address for all WPs: of course depends on the new name for the WP, as an example: workingparty.lupus@ , workingparty.vasculitis@etc.
 4. Each WP Secretary and Chair should get the ability to change their WP page: to load up documents and do other administrative tasks like updating contact information for Chairs/Secretary , add current projects, ask for contributors for projects etc. (Notably: WP Chair and Secretary are known by the webmaster and can easily be reached by the webmaster if he/she doesn't like what's on the site)
 5. Send out a monthly general PReS Newsletter: highlights in 1-2 pages, in this newsletter the WP can be advocated for, new projects can be brought under attention, and this will stimulate the activity of the WPs throughout the year.
- Secr/Chairs send in their, very concise, information for the newsletter (1 sentence to attract attention to a project with a link to the WP site in the newsletter)
6. Make a uniform lay-out with the website designer for a structured content that is identical for each WP, that should include:
 - email address of the WP
 - WP news
 - At the introductory page (startpage for all WP): introduce the concept of the WP.

After email exchanges, the Imaging WP approved Sylvia and Tamas' proposals and came up with a further suggestion (applicable to other WPs, if required):

- Imaging WP participants should be invited to upload a "mini-CV" with very short competences and interests, and email address.

For example: "Pediatric rheumatologist/Pediatrician/ Rheumatologist/Radiologist with 5 years experience in Pediatric Rheumatology/given field, ...certified for intermediate and advanced EULAR US courses...Tutor in 3 EULAR endorsed US courses...".
